


FROI SROI Reporting: 2025 release 3.1









Key Highlights of Release 3.1


- Revised 02 Change Process with the creation of the Change Segment
- Addition of Initial and Current Disability and Return To Work Dates
- New Narrative and Variable Segments
 - Part of Body moved from a Variable Segment
 - Supports multiple occurrences to maintain relationship of Part of Body Injury Code to new DN0421 – Part of Body Injury Location Code and DN0422 – Part of Body Injured Fingers/Toes Location
- Combining of Suspension MTCs (S1, S2, etc) into singular MTC (SX)
- Addition of Data Elements......





Data elements

Addition of Data Elements are a significant aspect of any implementation, no matter what product, but specifically when it comes to FROI SROI reporting.







New data elements

At the Fall 2024 annual meeting, NCCI submitted changes to both the EDI committee as well as the WCIO committee which would add an additional 6 data elements to the IDC Quarterly Record

Data Elements	
Classification Code	(4 bytes – Numeric)
Return to Work Date	(8 bytes – Numeric)
Zip Code of Injury Site	(9 bytes – Alpha Numeric)
Number of Dependents	(2 bytes – Numeric)
Exposure State Code	(1 byte – Numeric)
Indemnity Claim Code	(1 byte – Numeric)



Timeline for new data elements

Oct 10, 2024

NCCI, via Circular "IND-2024-01" published on 10/10/2024, provided the go live information

Feb 13, 2025

NJCRIB announced new data elements on Quarterly Records via Circular #2082 March 31, 2026

New data elements will go live for production reporting with the 'Q4 2025 Quarterly Records which are due by 3/31/2026

Oct 16, 2024

WCIO posted an announcement regarding approval of the new data elements


