Fulfill NMVTIS reporting requirements through ISO ClaimSearch®

Insurers, salvage pools, recyclers, shredders, dismantlers, and junkyards can meet [National Motor Vehicle Title Information System](#) (NMVTIS) requirements by reporting data to ISO ClaimSearch®. In turn, we'll report the information to NMVTIS on your behalf to fulfill your compliance needs.

The NMVTIS reporting service is free for all insurers participating in the ISO ClaimSearch standard auto layer.

Insurers can report total-loss data within their claim workflow

Reporting required loss information is simple. Just report the auto physical damage claim to ISO ClaimSearch. We'll add the claim to our database and return a match report. Once a total loss is determined and updated in ISO ClaimSearch, we'll forward the record to NMVTIS after 30 days. The service helps insurers:

- eliminate the cost of using an outside vendor
- streamline workflow by reporting through ISO ClaimSearch
- ensure compliance with NMVTIS regulations
- analyze their reportable data through an NMVTIS dashboard

To meet NMVTIS requirements, recyclers, shredders, dismantlers, and junkyards can report vehicle inventory directly to ISO ClaimSearch by submitting a data file via file transfer protocol (FTP).
